HOW DOES IT WORK?



WASTE CONSUMPTION

The worms compost the waste. Worms can process any organic material including kitchen waste, empty egg cartons or small amounts of garden trash. This is a sustainable way to dispose of waste.



REPRODUCTION

This method of waste processing is an ongoing process. The worms double every three months. So there are always enough worms to turn the waste into compost.







HARVESTING THE COMPOST

Is the bin full? Place a new bin on top of the full one. The worms will crawl towards the new waste and eventually the bottom bin will become worm-free. The compost from this bin can then be used for the garden.





SUSTAINABLE WASTE DISPOSAL

The worms produce moisture as well as compost. The bottom container collects this moisture. Mix it 50/50 with water and you have perfect nutrition for your plants!
